RESOURCE PERSON: Mr. Dashrath Prajapati & Mr. Hitharth Shah, Stock Arrow

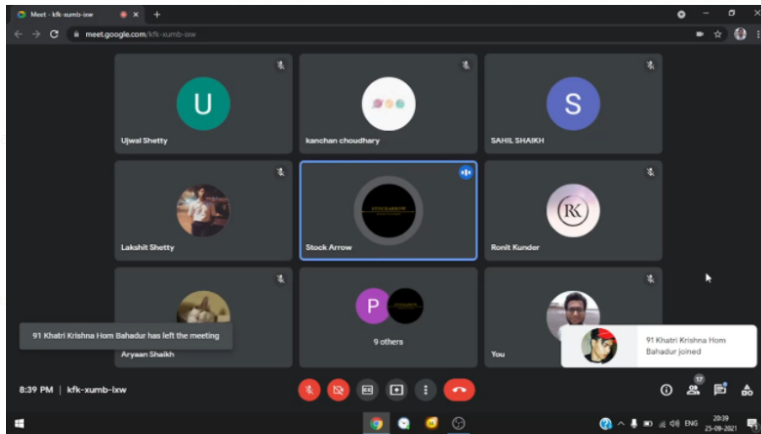
TEACHER INCHARGE: Asst. Prof. Ashish C. Navik
