

Post Donation Care	
Take more fluids orally than usual in the next 4 hours like fruit juices, water.	
Do not smoke for 30 minutes after donation Do not stand in sunlight for long.	
Do not drive any vehicle for 1 to 2 hours	
Avoid any heavy strenuous activity for that day like jogging, workout in the gymnasium etc.	
If there is bleeding from the phlebotomy site, raise the arm and apply pressure at the site.	
Remove bandage 5-6 hours after donation.	
 If there is a feeling of giddiness, either lie down or sin with head between the knees.
