

REPORT ON INDUSTRIAL VISIT 2023-24

The Department of BAMMC and BSCIT from Bunts Sangha's S.M. Shetty College of Science, Commerce, and Management Studies, Powai along with faculty members went on a 5-night/6-day industrial visit to Rajasthan from 11th to 16th March 2023. The trip covered three popular destinations in Rajasthan - Udaipur, Kumbhalgarh, and Chittorgarh. The purpose of this visit was to provide the students with an opportunity to gain practical knowledge and experience about the industries and culture of Rajasthan.

Day 1:
