


Rate on 5 point scale your level of satisfaction based on following criteria (1 being the lowest and 5 highest)



Rate on 5 point scale your level of satisfaction based on following criteria (1 being the lowest and 5 highest)




Rate on 5 point scale your level of satisfaction based on following criteria (1 being the lowest and 5 highest)






## Was the I.V. relevant to your course?




Was corrective measures taken in case of any problem during the tour?
