

E – WASTE COLLECTION, PLASTIC RECYCLE AND **REUSE & PAPER BAG MAKING**

A plastic waste bottle collection drive, in collaboration with Bisleri for the "Bottles for Change" project, collected 100 kg of plastic for recycling. Simultaneously, an Eco Brick Drive and a "Waste Collection Drive" were conducted with NSS Cell, University of Mumbai, UNDP, and the Government of Maharashtra, collecting 100 kg of mixed waste handed over to BMC. A paper bag-making activity was organized to promote environmental awareness, with volunteers creating 28,990 paper bags and distributing 4,215 to local vendors in the adopted area. The volunteers aimed to produce 60 paper bags daily.
